

ONS Station ALARA Committee Meeting 2nd Quarter June 27, 2022

Sheila Dalton opened with TAM and confirmed quorum.

Amanda Stevenson facilitated meeting.

Minutes from 1st Quarter meeting were reviewed and approved.

Bill Meldrum presented Site CRE . Discussion centered on the impact of the U2 Forced Outage.

Bobby Leigh discussed Work Group Exposure, which was impacted by the Forced Outage, CRDM work, and filters.

Bill presented exposure stats from the recently completed O3R31. 32.218 REM was a record low for U3. Top jobs impacting dose were Alloy 600, RV internal inspections, 3B1 RCP Motor replacement, LPSW piping. Non routine work accounted for 10 REM over baseline.

Bobby presented DRI status, including SF Crane pendants, SF Cooling Mod, technology advancements, Spot, UT pipe decon (NU-DEC).

SAC voted to approve tracking NU-DEC as a Dose Reduction Initiative.

SAC voted to move tracking of dose savings related to technological innovations to the Dose Advocate level.

On the DRI for filters Paul Fisk inquired about shield drum purchase – complete. Remaining items are EPRI Demin Study and replacing eye nuts with hex nuts on SF Filter housings.

Steve Snider questioned status of the SF Crane pendants, how we were tracking readiness to implement.
